Signing the form below will fulfill those requirements.

The following, is a list of topical applications commonly used for the treatment of scrapes, cuts, insect bites, etc..

Hydrogen peroxide (used to clean abrasions and cuts)

Triple Antibiotic Ointment (to prevent infection)

Bandages

Caladryl gel (for insect bites)

Benadryl spray (for insect bites)

Benadryl cream (for insect bites)

Aloe gel (for sunburn)

Lanolin (for chapped lips)

Eyewash (for dirt or foreign body in eye)

The school supplies all of these topical applications for your child.
